

NON-CERTIFIED VOTE COUNTS FROM APRIL 2019 COUNCIL ELECTION & MEMBER REFERENDUM

Council candidates ranked in order of number of votes received
(there were no qualified write-in candidates)

- 1. KARA CUSOLITO - 695 votes**
- 2. DAN HOFFMAN - 664 votes**
- 3. MARILYN CHASE - 657 votes**
- 4. DEBBIE MERITSKY - 645 votes**
- 5. HOPE SPITHALER - 617 votes**
- 6. LONDON McDANIELS - 606 votes**
- 7. JULES HOJNOWSKI - 552 votes**

NOTE: As of January 2019, in addition to receiving at least 50 votes, Council Candidates must meet all qualification requirements in order to be seated on Council. Candidate qualification will be determined and election results will be certified at the May 14th Council meeting.

In the Member Referendum as to selection of any new logo for the Co-op, a majority of those participating voted **YES** on both questions:

QUESTION #1 (requiring any new logo to use the name "GreenStar Cooperative Market," and that the process for selecting a new logo be "fully transparent to member-owners" and include as an option GreenStar's original "tree of life" logo)
YES - 528; NO - 283

QUESTION #2 (requiring a binding Membership vote on any new logo)
YES - 458; NO - 348

*A total of 814 member-owners cast valid ballots - 614 electronically, 200 by paper.
Not all voters participated in both the election and the referendum.*
